ARTIST STATEMENT

Encouraging an emotional response to color and form is the aim of Clara Berta's practice as an abstract painter. Inspired by the vibrancy and serenity of the natural world and the balance of forces within it, she creates works that contain flowing organic forms and energetic eruptions of color.

Her process is one of intuition, clearing the mind of preconceived notions of the final image while she works, allowing her thoughts and emotions to guide the movements. Berta adds layer upon layer until she reaches a compositional harmony between color, form, and negative space.

Influenced by a background in psychology, Berta's paintings can be perceived as depictions of psychological states or emotions, which, like her forms and compositions, are fluid and multilayered. Viewers often express feeling soothed, uplifted, and invigorated in the presence of these works.

Clara Berta is a contemporary abstract artist of Hungarian heritage, based in Laguna Beach, California, USA. She is known for large-scale paintings characterized by a sense of dynamism and fluidity that reflects the movement of the ocean.





Her latest paintings begin with an airbrushed base layer that enhances the sense of depth, followed by her technique of pouring and manipulating paint through movement, which generates a meditative sense of flow and buoyancy as well as dynamic kinetic bursts.


Most often, these opposing yet complementary forces are contained within one painting.

MAGICAL GOLD, 2023 - Acrylic on canvas - 36 x 60 in. / 91.4 x 152.4 cm.





Berta's 'Light' series exude a sense of light from within the vibrant colors of the paintings.


Dynamic bursts of energy, in balance with the translucent organic forms, convey the feeling of lightness from this flowing, buoyant series.





Together, her art and healing practice affirm a core belief: that creativity has the power to transform pain into beauty, and to connect us more deeply with ourselves and each other.
